

Travel to Cambridge Biomedical Campus, using Park & Ride Sites

There are many buses serving the Campus. This plan shows services that call at Park & Ride Sites and serve the campus without changing bus. Note that Busway prices are different to standard Park & Ride prices.

St Ives Park & Ride Site
-Take **Guided Bus A** to **the busway**
Addenbrooke's
Journey time approx. 50 mins
Departs at 15 minute intervals.

Longstanton Park & Ride Site
-Take **Guided Bus A** to Addenbrooke's
Journey time approx. 40 mins
Departs at 15 minute intervals.

Milton Park & Ride Site
- Take **Park and Ride Bus** to City Centre and walk to nearby stop for Green Park and Ride Bus to Addenbrooke's and Babraham Road

Newmarket Road Park & Ride Site
-Take **Park & Ride Bus** to City Centre and walk to nearby stop for Green Park and Ride Bus to Addenbrooke's and Babraham Road .
Journey time approx. 40 mins

Madingley Road Park & Ride Site
- Take **U (Universal) Bus** to Addenbrooke's (Blue Bus)
Journey time approx. 30 mins
Departs at 15-20 minute intervals

Trumpington Park & Ride Site
- Take **Guided Bus A** to Addenbrooke's
Journey time approx. 6 mins

Babraham Road Park & Ride Site
- Take **Park and Ride Bus** to Addenbrooke's and City Centre
Journey time approx. 5 mins

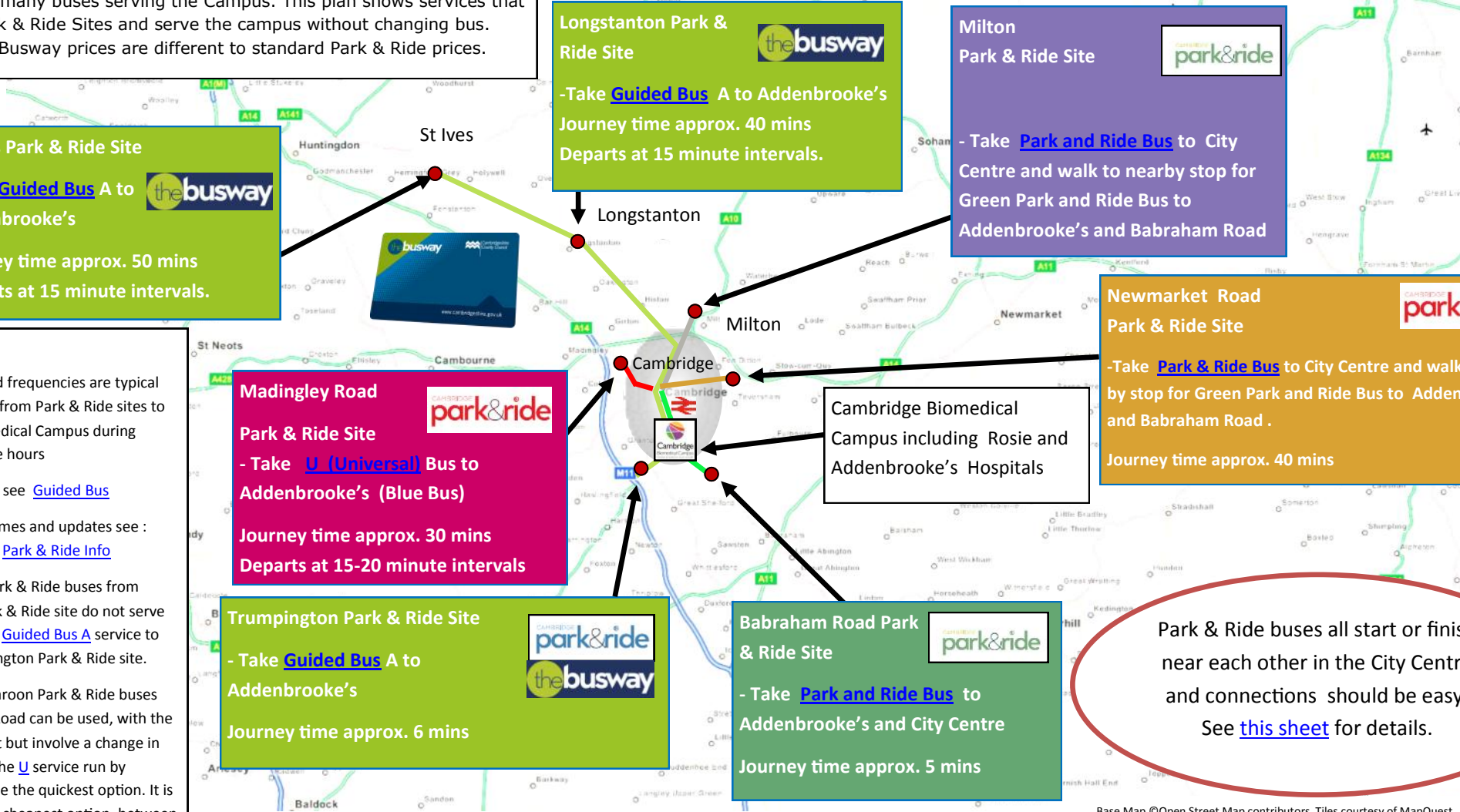
Cambridge Biomedical Campus including Rosie and Addenbrooke's Hospitals

Park & Ride buses all start or finish near each other in the City Centre and connections should be easy. See [this sheet](#) for details.

Note:
Journey times and frequencies are typical timetabled times from Park & Ride sites to Cambridge Biomedical Campus during weekday day time hours
For Busway times see [Guided Bus](#)

Note that Blue Park & Ride buses from Trumpington Park & Ride site do not serve the Campus. Use [Guided Bus A](#) service to and from Trumpington Park & Ride site.
Note also that Maroon Park & Ride buses from Madingley Road can be used, with the appropriate ticket but involve a change in the City Centre. The **U** service run by Whippet should be the quickest option. It is currently also the cheapest option, between Madingley Road and Campus, unless you have a Stagecoach ticket already, but ticket prices are subject to change.

There is a [parking charge](#) at all Park and Ride sites including St Ives and Longstanton. It costs £1 to park for up to 18 hours. You have up to 1 hour for payment to allow for drop off and pick up of passengers. You can pay for your parking in advance by using the [VivoPark website](#).

You can buy tickets for your journey at all Park & Ride sites, but regular travellers may want to look at options for smartcards or weekly tickets. See [Ticket Types](#) for options. Anyone buying a weekly or longer ticket from a Stagecoach bus will be given a [Smartcard](#), which can be topped up automatically if you choose. A [busway Smartcard](#) can be used on both Stagecoach and Whippet buses on the busway. Whippet offer a discounted ticket on the U service for students and University staff with appropriate identification as well as 10-Journey tickets. See the [Whippet website](#) for details.

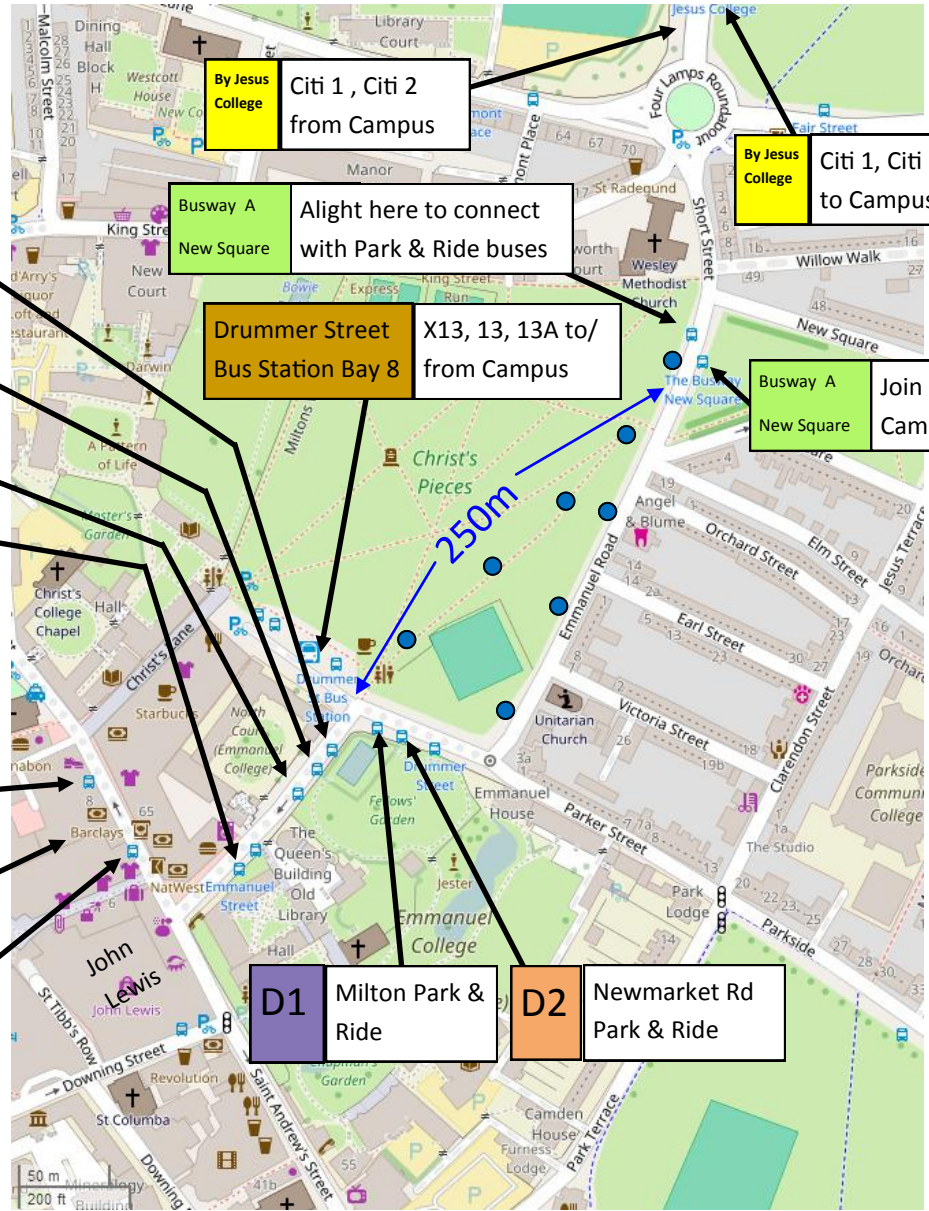
Travel to and from Cambridge Biomedical Campus via the City Centre using Bus and Park & Ride

Emmanuel Street Bus Stops

- E1** Citi 7 to/ from Campus
- E2** Citi 1 to Campus
- E3** Citi 2 to Campus
- E5** Addenbrooke's and Babraham Road Park & Ride

St Andrew's Street Bus Stops

- S1** Citi 1 from Campus
- S2** Citi 2 from Campus
- S3** Madingley Road Park & Ride



Travel Choices

There are a number of different bus services and tickets available for travelling to and from the Campus. Changing bus in the City Centre is not complicated, but you should think about which services you want to use and where on the Campus your journey is starting and finishing before choosing your ticket and service.

Choosing your service to get between the Campus and the City Centre

- **Rosie, Addenbrookes Treatment Centre (ATC) and that part of the Campus** use Dame Mary Archer Way bus stops and Citi 7 local bus service or Busway A. (Walk through Rosie Hospital to ATC).
- **Outpatients, Hospital Main Reception and that part of the Campus** use Addenbrooke's Bus Station for Green Park & Ride service, X13, 13, 13A, Citi 1, Citi 2 or Citi 7 local bus services or use Outpatients Bus Stop on Main Drive for Busway A.
- **Long Road Sixth Form College, MRC/ LMB and that part of the Campus** use Puddicombe Way or Robinson Way bus stops and Busway A or Citi 7.

Milton and Newmarket Road Park & Ride sites

- Use one of the above buses and interchange in the City Centre using Stop D1 (for Milton) or Stop D2 (for Newmarket Road).

Tickets For Park & Ride services a City Park & Ride day ticket can be used all day on any City Park & Ride buses (not U or Busway services). For Guided Busway a [smartcard](#) or appropriate Whippet or Stagecoach tickets are needed. The [best value tickets](#) are for long periods and are cheapest bought on-line.
