



Travel to Cambridge Biomedical Campus by Foot



Walking is a great way to get to Campus from many parts of the City and Babraham Road Park and Ride Site. It is also a good way to get some exercise and to get refreshed.

The plan shows some typical journey times by foot. These times will vary little however congested the roads are and for short trips can be quicker than car. If you walk fast you should have no trouble beating the indicated times.

Cambridge Guildhall and City Centre approximately 45 minutes walk via Hills Road.

Cambridge Station approximately 30 minutes walk via Hills Road.

Cherry Hinton approximately 35 minutes walk via Queen Edith's Way
